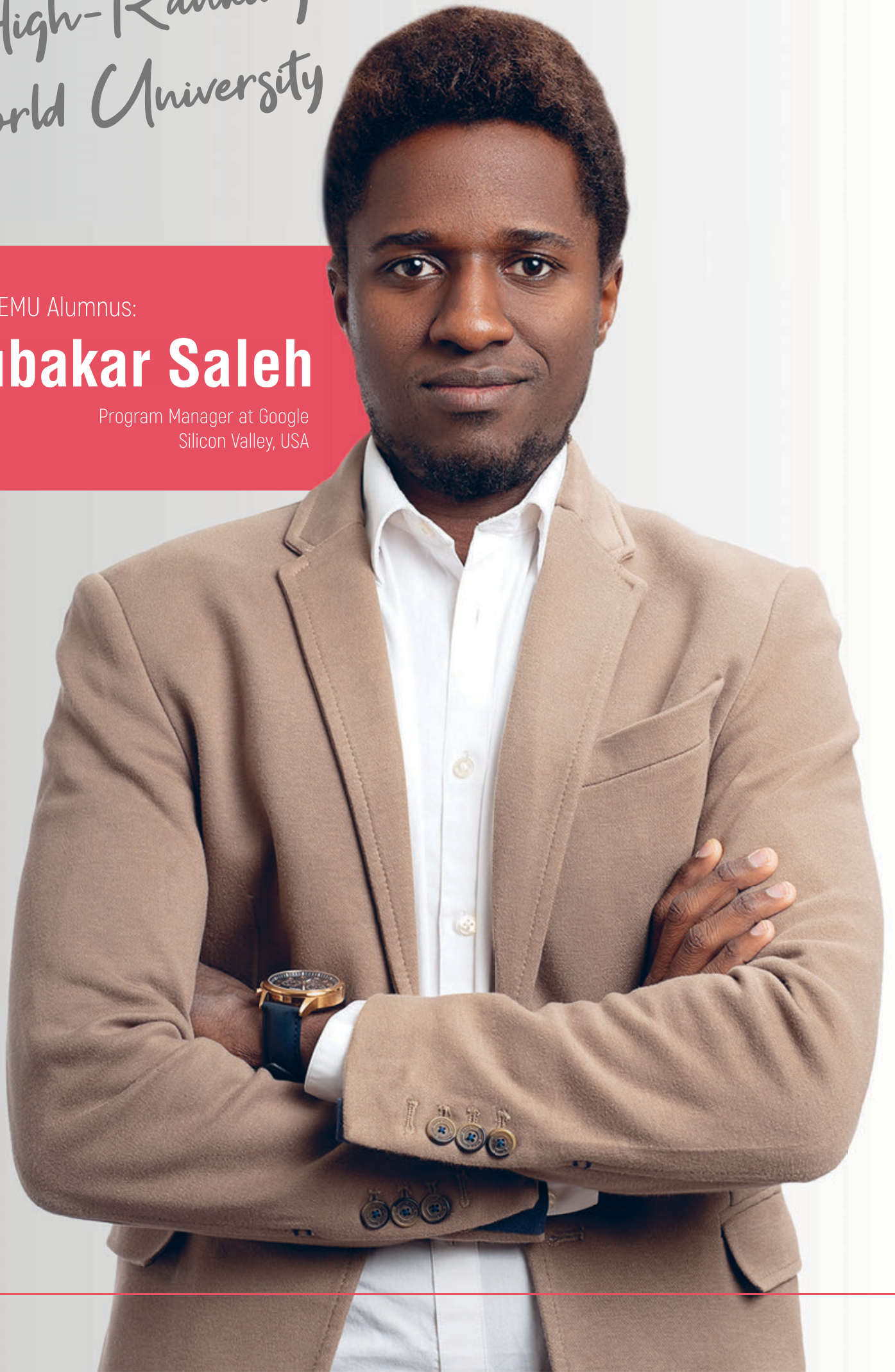

Application



Step 1

Step 4



Check your admission status via the online application portal-application and payment status section. You will receive your e-signed acceptance letter once your admission has been evaluated and you may proceed with the tuition fee payment. After your payment, your confirmation letter will be issued.

Step 2

You will receive your confirmation letter once your payment has been completed. You will be able to download it through the online application portal. Then, you may proceed with the visa application (if needed) procedures. Our university shares information with airport and sea entry points; of only those applicants whose admission and confirmation is fully complete.

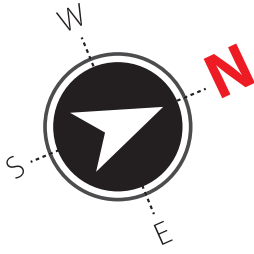

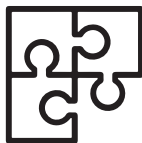

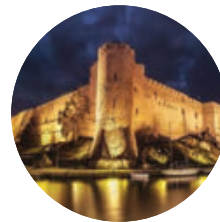
