# 1. Is EMU a public or private university?

EMU is a public university of Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC). EMU was established in 1979.

#### 2. Where is EMU?

EMU is located on the northern part of Cyprus. It is located in Famagusta, a city on the south east of the northern part of the island.

# 3. What is the world-ranking of EMU?

EMU is a Times Higher Education (THE) 601-800 ranked university.

EMU has been ranked 151-200 in THE Young University Rankings.

#### 4. What is the medium of instruction at EMU?

EMU is an English-medium university.

# 5. Which accreditations do the programs have?

Architecture program (Bachelor) has MiAK (Architectural Accreditation Board, Turkey) and NAAB (National Architectural Accreditation Board, USA) SE substantial equivalency. Interior Architecture program (Bachelor) has AQAS (Agency for Quality Assurance, Germany) accreditation (AQAS). Your diploma will have stamps of accreditation institutions at the back side. This means that your diploma is recognized in USA, Turkey, Europe and many other countries.

# 7. How much is the tuition fee for Faculty of Architecture undergraduate programs?

In case of admission, a large proportion of international students are granted 50 % scholarship.











Annual fee for Faculty of Architecture undergraduate programs is 5340,25 USD (after 50 % scholarship) (5% VAT, activity fund and health insurance are included)

# 8. How much is the tuition fee for Faculty of Architecture master programs?

In case of admission, a large proportion of international students are granted 50 % scholarship.

Every course within a master program is 760 USD (after 50% scholarship).

Faculty of Architecture masters programs comprise of 7 courses.

Thesis fee is 1141,88 USD (after 50% scholarship).

The activity fee per semester is 200 USD.

# 9. How much is the tuition fee for Architecture PhD program?

Every course within Architecture PhD program is 1297,88 USD.

Architecture PhD program comprises of 7 courses.

Thesis registration fee is 1700,13 USD

Photocopies of Higher Secondary School Certificate and transcript (mark sheets).

One passport-sized photograph

Photocopy of the international passport (relevant data page) or birth certificate A copy of proof of English Proficiency if any











# 21. What are the documents required for Transfer Application?

Photocopies of Higher Secondary School Certificate / Diploma and Associate Degree or a National Diploma

Academic record / mark sheets (transcript)

Short course descriptions

Photocopy of the international passport (relevant data page) or birth certificate

One photograph

# 22. Documents needed for Graduate Applications

An official transcript of all university-level courses taken. A comparative mark/grade table if CGPA on the transcript is not out of 4.00.

Attested photocopies of diplomas received from a university or equivalent institutions (i.e. 4 years study bachelor degree). English translations of these documents are necessary if they are in any language other than English.

Documentation of scores received for English and academic proficiency exams/tests. This is not valid for the programs in which the medium of instruction is Turkish. Native speakers should indicate the place of birth and citizenship. All others should provide documents of any one of the below given English Proficiency Tests.

Three letters of reference (not required for EMU graduates).

#### **Documents**

Give details of any grant/scholarships that you have already been awarded (valid for your studentship at EMU) (add documents).

Give details of any application(s) for a grant/scholarship that you have made (add documents).

Statement of Purpose / Intention (Please submit on a separate sheet: Your purpose in applying to the program chosen, explaining your motivation as well as the areas of specialization which would be of interest to you within the discipline).











A photocopy of your passport or I.D. card (relevant data page).

Two passport-sized (approx. 6 cm x 5 cm) photographs.

Program specific documents: Architecture (Ph.D. & Master): Portfolio.

Candidates are required to submit a document of financial guarantee showing that sufficient funds are available for tuition and living expenses.

Note: English translations of these documents are necessary if they are in any language other than English.

To travel to northern Cyprus, you must first travel to Turkey, where you may board a plane that travels to Ercan airport in northern Cyprus.

Therefore, it is advisable to go through their website (link provided), and find out if your country is included for a visa or not.
