# 8- How much is the tuition fee for Faculty of Arts and Sciences undergraduate programs?

In case of admission, a large proportion of international students are granted automatic 50 % scholarship.











Annual fee for Faculty of Arts and Sciences undergraduate programs is **4405,75 USD** (after 50 % scholarship) (5% VAT, activity fund and health insurance are included)

For undergraduate applicants that have shown high performance in their home country in university entrance system, 2 best students among applicants from each country may receive 100 % scholarship. All scholarship applications will be evaluated two times once 60 and again 30 days prior to the beginning of the semester. This scholarship only covers tuition for the regular duration of the academic program. You may send your application letter and supporting documents to <a href="mailto:scholarships@emu.edu.tr">scholarships@emu.edu.tr</a> at least 60 days prior to the beginning of the semester for first consideration or 30 days prior to the beginning of the semester for second consideration. (Late %100 scholarship applications cannot be considered)

#### 19- Does EMU require IELTS?

No. Students with valid documents showing their language level (see exemption criteria) can be exempted from the English Preparatory Program. Students who have no documents regarding their language level are required to take the EMU FLEPS English Proficiency Exam Stage I. If students are placed at the highest level in this exam, they are required to sit the EMU FLEPS English Proficiency Exam Stage II.

#### 20- What are the documents required for Undergraduate Application?

- Photocopies of Higher Secondary School Certificate and transcript (mark sheets).
- One passport-sized photograph
- Photocopy of the international passport (relevant data page) or birth certificate
- A copy of proof of English Proficiency if any

## 21- What are the documents required for Transfer Application?

- Photocopies of Higher Secondary School Certificate / Diploma and Associate Degree or a National Diploma
- Academic record / mark sheets (transcript)
- Short course descriptions











- Photocopy of the international passport (relevant data page) or birth certificate
- One photograph

#### 22- Documents needed for Graduate Applications

- An official transcript of all university-level courses taken. A comparative mark/grade table if CGPA on the transcript is not out of 4.00.
- Attested photocopies of diplomas received from a university or equivalent institutions (i.e. 4 years study bachelor degree). English translations of these documents are necessary if they are in any language other than English.
- Documentation of scores received for English and academic proficiency exams/tests. This is not valid for the programs in which the medium of instruction is Turkish. Native speakers should indicate the place of birth and citizenship. All others should provide documents of any one of the below given English Proficiency Tests.
- Three letters of reference (not required for EMU graduates).

#### Documents

Give details of any grant/scholarships that you have already been awarded (valid for your studentship at EMU) (add documents). Give details of any application(s) for a grant/scholarship that you have made (add documents).

Statement of Purpose / Intention (Please submit on a separate sheet: Your purpose in applying to the program chosen, explaining your motivation as well as the areas of specialization which would be of interest to you within the discipline).

A photocopy of your passport or I.D. card (relevant data page).

Two passport-sized (approx. 6 cm x 5 cm) photographs.

*Note:* English translations of these documents are necessary if they are in any language other than English.

#### 25- How can I travel to Northern Cyprus?

To travel to northern Cyprus, you must first travel to Turkey, where you may board a plane that travels to Ercan airport in northern Cyprus.

#### 26- Do I require visa?

Depending on your country, you may require a visa to enter any Turkish Territory (North Cyprus Inclusive), as stipulated by the Turkish Ministry of Foreign Affairs <a href="http://www.mfa.gov.tr/visa-information-for-foreigners.en.mfa">http://www.mfa.gov.tr/visa-information-for-foreigners.en.mfa</a>. Therefore, it is advisable to go through their website (link provided), and find out if your country is included for a visa or not.
